"The results speak for themselves and show that in our efforts to keep drivers healthy we got a lot right during the development phase: Seat surfaces, backrests and adjustment options meet ergonomic requirements, while the seats feature optimum upholstery. The testers rate the control panel concepts very highly from an ergonomic point of view, and the vibration characteristics data also tell a convincing story."
